My 1987 Dodge Raider had approximately 72,000 miles on it in 1992, when the transmission started flaring when shifting gears. I had estimates at three locations on what it would take to repair the transmission. The lowest estimate came in at \$1050. I figured at that point my best bet would be to drive the vehicle until the transmission went out and then either replace the vehicle or the transmission.

Instead I was introduced to Bishop's Original Formula automatic transmission treatment. I drained the old transmission fluid, added the treatment and within 100 miles or so the flaring had ceased, the transmission was shifting normally and my gas mileage increased significantly.

I'm very impressed with the Bishop products and completely satisfied with the products I've used thus far.
