I was a supervisor on a project for Alyeska Pipeline Service Company doing a upgrade of the security detection systems at the bridge crossings.

We were installing grounding wire to the poles on the fence of the E field detection system. When we started drilling and tapping the poles to attach the ground lugs for the ground wire, we were using a drill bit and a tap up about every 8 to 10 poles. We decided to try the APL penetrating lube and this ended the deterioration of the bits and taps. In fact we did over a hundred steel posts and the drill and tap was still OK. Also the drill bits did not get hot and cut into the pole much easier. And the tap was easier to thread into the pole.

This saved us quite a bit of time and expense of drills and taps by using the your APL penetrating lube.
