

To Whom It May Concern:

I own a 1992 Freightliner tractor. It has a 460B cat engine, 20 speed transmission, and 556 gear differentials.

I was informed of Bishop's Original Products (BOP) by Don Gibson and how they could improve the performance of my Tractor by reducing friction.


I first installed it in the Motor and made a trip from Fairbanks, AK to Anchorage AK. I notice an improvement on the power and performance of my tractor. On the return trip I added the Diesel additive to the diesel fuel and noticed the engine was running smoother and seemed to gain power.

I then added the Gear Treatment to the transmission and differentials. The first thing I noticed was that the temperature dropped in both the transmission and both differentials. Before the transmission and differentials were running about 180 to 220 on level ground and on hills, would climb to 350 to 400 degrees with heavy loads. After the treatment they indicated barely above the cold mark and on hills, with heavy loads, did not go above 220 degrees.

After using the BOP products for six months I have shown an increase in mileage by 1.2 miles per gal. This equates to 23 % increase on fuel mileage.

I highly recommend the BOP products if you want to decrease your operation costs. With the reduced friction you will have less chance of oil breakdown and parts failing because the oil is running at a cooler temperature. Also with the fuel savings this equates to quite a saving in operation costs.
